BUDGET 2003/2004 (6/1/1/1) (CEMFM) (P 2 : SEPARATE COVER ANNEXURES P 1 - 214 AND 215 - 289)

COUNCIL RESOLVED : (27 MAY 2003)

IT WAS RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL : (27.05.2003)

[CEMFM] 1. That Council **APPROVE** the Draft Budgets for 2003/2004 and applicable tariffs.

2. That the second Budget Presentation be made to Council before 30 June 2003, at which the budget will be compiled in terms of the National Treasury format without affecting the figures in the Draft Budget 2003/2004.

[EMCS] 3. That the Operating Budget comprising of R723 507 000 expenditure and an income of R723 507 000 as reflected in the Annexures of the agenda of Council dated 27 May 2003, **BE APPROVED** as the Council's Operating Budget for the financial year 2003/2004;

4. That the Operating Budget approved in paragraph (3) above, **BE SUBMITTED** to the Director-General of Finance for approval;

[CEMFM] 5. That the domestic electricity tariffs **WILL BE** 0,2974 per kWh **WITH**
[EMCS] **EFFECT** from 1 July 2003 subject to approval of the National Electricity Regulator.

[CEMFM] 6. That due to the increase in operating expenditure, as well as an expected increase of 8.5 % in the price of water from 1 July 2003, all the Council's current water user tariffs **BE INCREASED AS FOLLOWS WITH EFFECT** from 1 July 2003:

Water

0 - 6 kl - Nil (Residential)

0 - 6 kl - R8.98 All other users (excluding schools and churches)

7 - 50kl - R8.98 All other users (excluding schools and churches)

51 - higher - R11.88 All other users (excluding schools and churches)

Schools and churches : R7,55 per kl regardless of consumption.

[CEMFM] 7. That the refuse removal tariffs for all categories of users of the service
[EMCS] **BE INCREASED** with effect from 1 July 2003 by 12%, and that all existing rebates, remissions or discounts previously allowed to certain users of the services, **BE ADJUSTED** to accommodate the increase;

[CEMFM] 8. That assessment rates levied on all classes of property within Council's
[EMCS] jurisdiction **BE INCREASED AS FOLLOWS WITH EFFECT** from 1 July 2003:

Assessment Rates :

Residential - 17,612c

Business - 26,417c

Industrial - 26,417c

Agricultural - 08,887c (current ratable holdings)

[CEMFM] 9. That the sewerage tariffs/charges **BE INCREASED** with effect
[EMCS] from 1 July 2003, by 12 % and that all existing rebates, remissions or discounts previously allowed to certain users of the service **BE ADJUSTED** to accommodate the increase;

- [CEMFM] 10. That it be noted that Council **will give** each household a free 6kl water
[EMCS] which amounts to an estimated monetary value of: R53,88 per household.
- [CEMFM] 11. That it be noted that Council **will credit** each household's account
[EMCS] with a R10,00 electricity discount.
- [MM] 12. That the Municipal Manager **ENSURES**, that in giving effect to paragraph 5 above, all requirements necessary to ensure that the Council complies with relevant legislation, including NER directives, **ARE COMPLIED** with.
